

Contributor Agreement for “From Earth to the Solar System2013”

This is an agreement between the United States Government, as represented by the Administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (‘NASA’) under the authority of Title 51 USC Section 20113(e) of the National Aeronautics and Space Act of 1958, and those persons contributing images (referred to as ‘Contributor’) for the “From Earth to the Solar System” project wherein:

- A. NASA is gathering rights to a limited collection of images to make them available to organizations worldwide. These organizations will conduct public exhibitions entitled “From Earth to the Solar System” (‘the Exhibition’) that will include the contributed images, and
- B. The Contributor has submitted one or more images (“Contributor Images”) for inclusion in the Exhibitions.

It is agreed that:

1. Contributor has submitted Contributor Images using the “From Earth to the Solar System” project website (<http://fettss.arc.nasa.gov>).
2. Contributor hereby grants to the Government, and those acting on behalf of the Government, and also any entity that enters into an Exhibition Agreement with NASA the express permission without payment to publicly display, distribute, or reproduce the Contributor Images.
3. Copies of the Contributor Images supplied for the Exhibitions (‘the Work’) may be included as part of the Exhibitions and, if selected for inclusion, on any non-commercial, promotional materials used to publicize the Exhibitions.
4. NASA will endeavour to include agreed-upon image credit information for Contributor Images not in the public domain.
5. Contributor represents that either he or she owns rights in and is the owner of the Contributor Images or such images are in the public domain, as identified in the Image Credit.
6. Where the Contributor owns rights in and is the owner of the Contributor Image, Contributor will retain exclusive copyright in the Work.
7. NASA is not responsible for any damage or loss of images or digital files supplied by the Contributor while they are in the possession of NASA, it being the Contributor’s

responsibility to insure such original images against loss and to maintain archival copies of digital files submitted if so desired.

8. The accuracy of the Contributor Images, including rights and references is the responsibility of the Contributor.
9. NASA also receives the perpetual right to retain, reproduce, distribute and publicly display copies of Contributor Images solely to share information about and to document the various Exhibitions carried out throughout the world.
10. The Exhibitions period begins in 2013 and lasts through December, 2018.
11. This agreement is governed by United States federal law.
